Description: Proposal to conduct routine maintenance of City stormwater outfalls within Gages Slough. The proposed work will involve removing brush and accumulated sediment near 17 culverts and stormwater outfalls. Some, or all, of the proposed work will occur within regulated wetlands or wetland buffers and within the jurisdictions of the City's Shoreline Master Program (SMP).

Permit Number(s): SHE 1-22

Applicant: John Abenroth, City of Burlington Public Works Department

Lead Agency: The City of Burlington, Community Development Department

Location/Parcel Number: Not site specific. Work will occur at 17 separate locations along the Gages Slough corridor.

Permits & Studies: This application includes a shoreline exemption permit application, SEPA checklist, maps, and a table identifying the proposed scope of work at each culvert or outfall location.

SEPA: The lead agency is utilizing the optional State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) process provided for in WAC 197-11-355 and expects to issue a MDNS. Additional mitigation measures may be required whether or not an EIS is required. Comments on the environmental impacts associated with the proposed action, or on the associated permits, must be submitted to the Burlington Planning Department by 5:00 P.M. June 7, 2022. This may be the only opportunity provided to comment on this proposal
