The following agenda items will be considered:

1. **Public Hearing:** 2026 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) Update – The Planning Commission will review a final draft of the proposed 2026 CIP. The CIP includes a list of proposed capital projects, including construction or improvements related to parks, city buildings, utilities, firefighting, and transportation. The CIP includes estimated project costs and identifies funding sources for proposed projects. The Planning Commission may take action on this item.
2. **Public Meeting:** 2026 Comprehensive Plan Update – Transportation Element - The Planning Commission will review the recently completed Active Transportation and Safety (ATS) plan which will serve as the basis for updates and changes to the Transportation Element of the Burlington Comprehensive Plan. The ATS plan includes a safety analysis of the City's transportation system, identifies projects to address safety concerns, establishes multimodal level of service (LOS) standards, and includes a proposed non-motorized transportation network. Discussion only. No action will be taken on this item.
3. **Public Meeting:** 2026 Comprehensive Plan Update – Substantive Code Changes – The Planning Commission will review proposed substantive change to the Burlington Municipal Code necessary to implement the updated Comprehensive Plan. Discussion only. No action will be taken on this item.
